The Evolution of Breezy Point Resort, Part 13

Golf has always been a mainstay at Breezy Point Resort. This issue delves into the early development of the courses and the personalities of those who played the links.

"Captain Billy" Fawcett's vision for Breezy Point Lodge began before he even stepped on the property in February of 1921.

As a playground for his rich and famous friends, he meticulously planned a luxurious resort for relaxation in the woods that would include facilities for every guest, no matter what their interests may be.

The menu of activities was astounding. His plans materialized in short order and included a stable with saddle horses, trapshooting range, fishing boats and guides, airplane excursions, bowling, billiards, a zoo with native animals, a water wheel and water slide on the beach, gambling and, of course, golf.

The spring of 1922 saw work start on the front nine of what is today's Traditional Golf Course. The land was rugged and clearing the intense brush and jack pines consumed the better part of the summer. After this initial clearing was completed the fairways and greens were sculpted, much of it with shovels and rakes, and the steel piping for irrigation was installed. A large portion of the original irrigation system is still in use today.

Next came countless truckloads of black dirt and hand seeding. With continual attention, the course was ready for play in early 1923.

The course was named Chippewa and became a

Midwest favorite. In 1924 Fawcett, a master at promotion, hosted the 10,000 Lakes Tournament, an annual event that would continue until 1965.

During the first 10 years of the tournament Les Bolstad won 3 times and Harry Legg won twice.

Bolstad's first win was in 1925 when he was 17. In 1926 he won the National Public Links Championship and in 1927 he won the Big Ten Championship. For the next few years, he was one of the top Minnesota golfers. He then chose to devote his golf skills to teaching and coaching the Minnesota Gophers from 1947 to 1976.

The Brainerd Dispatch on June 29, 1929 reported, "Harry Legg, Minneapolis, will again defend his title in the 10,000 Lakes Golf Tournament at Breezy Point Lodge. Legg, winner the past two years, is a former Western Amateur champ, six-time Trans-Mississippi champ, plus various other wins."

Legg was unable to make it 3 in a row and lost to Roscoe Fawcett, Captain Billy's brother.

As the golf activity at the Lodge grew, so did the demand for caddies.

Fawcett had a preference for hiring local boys as caddies, some of whom were as young as 10 years old. This was a tiresome job for these youngsters. There were no carts so the clubs were carried on their backs. One former caddie remarked that the golf club bags were made heavier when the golfers further loaded them with their bottles of liquor.

The tournaments were not just reserved for men. The women's tournaments also held the public's attention.

During the first 10 years of the tournament, Mrs. Ralph Little of the Minneapolis Golf Club won 5.

Patty Berg, who would go on to national golfing fame, won 3 back-to-back tournaments in 1933 to 1935. Her first win was at the age of 15. Amazingly, she had taken up golf only 2 years earlier.

Fawcett's publishing business that had started with *Captain Billy's Whiz Bang* was growing by leaps and bounds. He expanded into the motion picture world, publishing magazines such as *Screen Secrets*, *Screen Book*, *Hollywood*, *True Confessions* and *Screen Play* that featured movie stars and other luminaries.

Thus he became a member of Hollywood's inner circle and often hosted the stars at the Lodge. His reputation and contacts enabled him to attract to the Lodge personalities from the sporting and literary circles as well.

It was these contacts that, in July of 1925, brought Walter Hagen to the Lodge for an exhibition game. Hagen had won the US Open in 1914 and 1919, the British Open in 1922 and 1924 and the PGA

Championships in 1921 and 1924. He went on to win a total of 5 PGA Championships, 4 British Opens and captained the U.S. in the first 6 Ryder Cups.

Fawcett, never one to shy away from publicity, added some intrigue to Hagen's appearance.

The Brainerd Dispatch in its July 15, 1925, edition reported, "Captain William H. Fawcett, who led the victorious Olympic trapshooting team, has ascertained that Hagen is a trapshooter too

and has evolved a combination match. The Captain and Hagen will play a golf game. Par 18 holes is 72. When the golf is disposed of, Hagen and the Captain will shoot 72 clay birds and statisticians will then figure out who won the golf-trapshooting championship. And when Hagen has finished this strenuous day, he will go fishing on Big Pelican Lake."

Although the news reports after the exhibition provided glowing details of Hagen's golfing prowess, no mention was made of Fawcett's trapshooting challenge.

A news article in August of 1929 reported the growing tourist industry in the Brainerd area. It claimed

Breezy Point North Stars



Whitebirch, Inc. recently acquired from the North American Hockey League (NAHL) a franchise for a hockey team in the Junior Tier III circuit. The team, named Breezy Point North Stars, will be based at the Breezy Point Ice Arena.

Recruiting for players will begin shortly. The recruitment of as many Minnesota players as possible will be attempted but at least half the roster will most likely be from all over the US. One or two players from outside the U.S. may be carried.

The NAHL is the largest USA Hockey-sanctioned Junior circuit with 28 teams representing some of the nation's emerging hockey markets as well as traditional hot beds.

Recruitment will be conducted by Joe Bergquist, general manager of the Ice Arena, and the head coach Bryan Henrichs.

The goals of junior hockey are to promote, develop and administer the domestic USA Hockey program for junior-aged players, teams and leagues and is available to athletes who are 20 & under as of the 31st day of December of the current season of competition.

Players who are selected for the team and accept a contract will arrive around the first week in September to start practice for the season.

They will be living at the dormitory alongside of the arena.

This year there will be 18 teams in the league, including Little Falls, St Cloud and Vadnais Heights MN, Battle Creek and Flint, MI, Chicago and Peoria, IL, Cleveland, Cincinnati and Toledo, OH, Pittsburgh, PA, Quad Cities, IA and St. Louis, MO.

The program is available to high school students and graduates who seek a greater or different challenge than that which might be available through their prep school team, high school varsity or club team or area 18 & under teams.

The season will begin in September with 48 to 60 games scheduled through March, at which time the playoffs will begin.

The principal purpose of this development program is to prepare the athlete for career advancement either in a collegiate program or a professional opportunity.

Bob Spizzo, Whitebirch Inc. CEO, "I am truly excited about this great addition to the hockey scene in the Brainerd Lakes Area. The Breezy Point North Stars will not only generate new jobs and entertainment in our area but, more importantly, will create an environment in which these young players can sharpen their hockey skills while preparing themselves for leadership roles in the future."

As a point of clarification, this is not a traditional semi-pro team. On the contrary, the league regulations purposefully protect the amateur status of all participants under the rules and guidelines established by the International Ice Hockey Federation, USA Hockey, Hockey Canada, the NCAA, the NAIA and the National Federation of High Schools.

that Brainerd was the headquarters for 150,000 tourists who visited the area in 1928 and that in the area there were 800 sleeping and housekeeping cottages capable of accommodating over 10,000 people. It was estimated that tourists spent \$275,000 in the area.

On October 24, 1929, "Black Thursday", the stock market crashed, dragging the country into the Great Depression.

Fawcett, always the optimist, had thus far been successful in luring the top golfers in the nation to his course but also realized that in order to better compete with the courses in the Twin Cities he had to create a back nine.

Plans for the back nine were drawn and a public announcement of the expansion was made in the August 26, 1930, issue of the *Brainerd Dispatch*. "The Breezy Point Lodge golf course is to be enlarged from a nine-hole to an 18-hole course, with works starting in September. It is expected to be ready for play next July 4th. Capt. Fawcett had purchased many additional acres of land for just this purpose."

Quietly, the expansion plans were put on hold.

Walter Hagen - The Legend

Born Dec. 21, 1892, in Rochester New York, Walter Hagen at age five began playing golf in the family cow pasture. "I would herd the cows all in one spot where I had made a hole, so they could eat the grass and make a close putting surface."

He caddied at an exclusive country club where the club pro, Andy Christy, gave him lessons. One day a cocky Hagen challenged his mentor, "How about my beating you nine fast holes?"

"His eyes covered me slowly for a few seconds," Hagen later recalled, "then he said, 'Young man, when I want to play golf, I'll ask you.' Then he turned and walked away."

"Was my face red! What a lesson he taught me. I never forgot that. Afterwards when I wanted to play with him I was always careful to ask politely, 'Would you play a few holes with me, Mr. Christy, and give me some pointers on the game?'"

Hagen continued his golf while working as a taxidermist. He also played semi-pro baseball and was about to be scouted by the Philadelphia Phillies in Florida in 1914. He can-

celled the baseball tryout to play in a golf tournament, winning the U.S. Open at Midlothian Country Club at Blue Island, Ill. At age 21, doors started to open.

Hanging around exclusive country clubs gave him a taste for fine clothes. Tall and handsome with sleek black hair, he dressed elegantly and enjoyed being dapper. His expertise at golf allowed him to mingle with the elite on the course, but at the time golfers were not allowed entry into the clubs themselves, especially in England.

Hagen, who won the U.S. Open again in 1919 and then went on to win four British Opens in 1922, 1924, 1928 and 1929, changed all that with the force of his own personality, mingling with the creme of world society.

Hagen's attitude on the golf course made him popular not only with the elite but with other golfers and fans. A tournament official irritated by Hagen's lateness to the tee once asked, "Practicing a few shots, Walter?" "Nope," said The Haig, "having a few."

He attracted a huge following and often outdueled the

other famous golfers of the era, including Ben Hogan, Byron Nelson and Sam Snead. But in 1950 when sports writers voted Bobby Jones the greatest golfer in the first half of the century, Hagen said "I would have voted for Jones, myself. He was marvelous."

In 1926 Hagen challenged Jones to a pair of 36-hole matches in Florida. Hagen won both. "It was my greatest thrill in golf," he said.

Hagen traveled the world and played in more than 2,000 tournaments, but he chose to live in Michigan at the Detroit Athletic Club and the Book Cadillac Hotel. In 1954 he moved to a 20-acre estate near Traverse City overlooking East Long Lake.

Hagen once played golf with King Edward VIII, who later gave up the throne to marry, becoming the Duke of Windsor. "Hey Eddie, hold the flag, would you please," Walter yelled at the king, to the astonishment of the British gallery.

Among Detroit royalty, Hagen told about playing with Edsel Ford at the Detroit Golf Club one day: "As I approached Edsel he yelled to his caddie, standing some paces away, to bring over his bag. He reached for the bag, unzipped a large pocket, and fumbled around inside it. A .38 automatic pistol dropped to his feet.

"I drew back in pretended alarm. 'Edsel,' I said, 'If you want this hole so badly, I'll concede it. You can certainly have it!'"

Ford grinned and explained the gun was a result of kidnapping threats.

Hagen retired in 1939.

Jeff Johnson

A tour of Breezy Point Resort's sprawling grounds and facilities amazes locals and tourists alike. The orderly development of the Resort has been timed to take advantage of the growing number of tourists discovering the Resort.

This growth doesn't magically happen. The coordinating efforts of Jeff Johnson, White Birch, Inc. project manager, is the key ingredient to insure the Resort's projects are completed properly and on time.

Johnson, a native of Staples, MN, served in the maintenance department at Anoka/Ramsey Community College for 10 years.

He joined White Birch, Inc. in 1995 as quality control manager and recalls his first duties as replacing light bulbs in the Pinewood Cabanas. His duties included inspecting the Resort's lodg-

ing units to insure all guest facilities were in order.

1999 was a turning point for Johnson when he was assigned to oversee the Eagles Nest development. With that project successfully completed, he then began work on the White Birch Estates development and the remodeling of the Ice Arena's dormitory.

In 2001, Johnson was promoted to project manager. His responsibilities were expanded to include construction oversight. The construction of Campground Cluster II was his first project and required the coordination of the building of roads and installation of utilities for 119 campsites.

In 2002 he became the liaison between White Birch and the City of Breezy Point, Crow Wing County and the Thirty Lakes Watershed District. In this role Johnson is responsible for all regulatory permit applications and approvals necessary for the Resort's ongoing expansion projects.

Johnson's job is stressful, to say the least. Juggling contractors' availability with material deliveries and the vagaries of weather is a constant threat to the timely completion of each project. Always in the back of his

mind is the fact that each project's deadline is the day before guests arrive to use the new facility.

When asked about the most memorable experience he's had at the Resort, his response is surprisingly not of missing deadlines or other calamities, but of having Faith Hill and Tim McGraw, famous country singers, as Resort guests.

Jeff and his family live in Pequot Lakes.

- Angel hair pasta
- 3 oz. butter
- 1.5 oz. julienned onions
- 1.5 oz. julienned bell peppers (red, green, yellow)
- 1 oz. sundried tomatoes
- 1 oz. artichokes
- 1 Tbsp chopped garlic
- 1 Tbsp capers (optional)

- Pinch of kosher salt
- Thinly sliced chicken or shrimp if desired
- 1/4 cup white wine
- Fresh chopped basil and Parsley according to taste (about two large chopped basil leaves and pinch of chopped parsley)

Cook angel hair pasta according to recipe on box/bag. Saute butter on medium to high heat until it begins to brown.

Add all ingredients to browned butter and sauté for about 3-4 minutes or until chicken or shrimp is fully cooked. Turn to high heat and deglaze with about 1/4 cup white wine.

Let simmer for about 1.5-2 minutes constantly mixing until wine has cooked down and thickened to a sauce like consistency.

Remove from heat, add fresh chopped herbs and combine with about 8 oz. angel hair pasta.

Back then, we didn't fire up an engine and burn gasoline just to cut the lawn. We used a push mower that ran on human power. We exercised by working so we didn't need to go to a health club to run on treadmills that operate on electricity.

But she's right; we didn't have the green thing back then.

We drank from a fountain when we were thirsty instead of from a plastic bottle filled with water shipped in from another state or country. We refilled writing pens with ink instead of buying a new pen, and we replaced the

razor blades in a razor instead of throwing away the whole razor just because the blade got dull.

Back then, people took the streetcar or a bus and kids rode their bikes to school or walked. We had one electrical outlet in a room, not an entire bank of sockets to power a dozen appliances. And we didn't need a computerized gadget to receive a signal beamed from satellites 2,000 miles out in space in order to find the nearest pizza joint.

We wanted to improve our lives but we weren't so hungry for expensive gadgets and services that mom and dad both had to have jobs in order to pay the bills... we didn't need huge TVs, iPods, video cameras, personal computers, cell phones, cable, internet, ATVs, Playstations, jet skis, snowmobiles, carbon fiber tennis rackets and titanium golf clubs. We got along without that stuff, and some of us even had savings accounts and time to talk to our next door neighbors over the hedge instead of via email or text messaging.

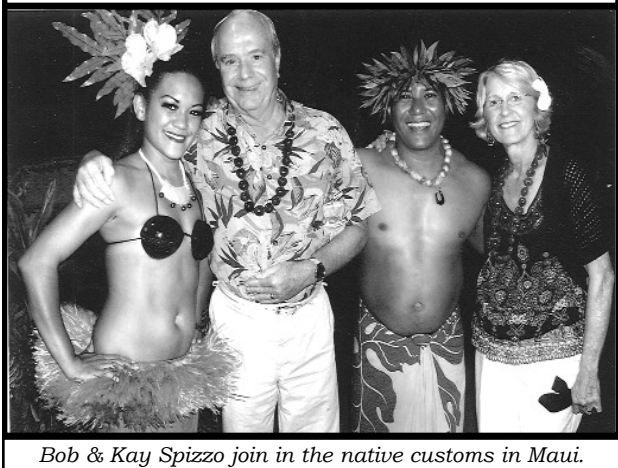

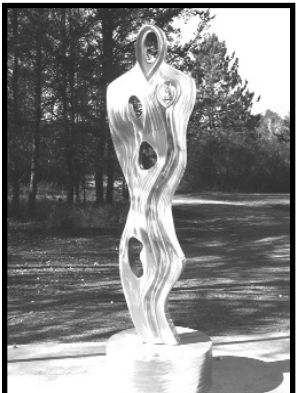

The City received from a private party a \$10,000 grant to begin the project; however, an additional \$3,300 is needed to complete the project.

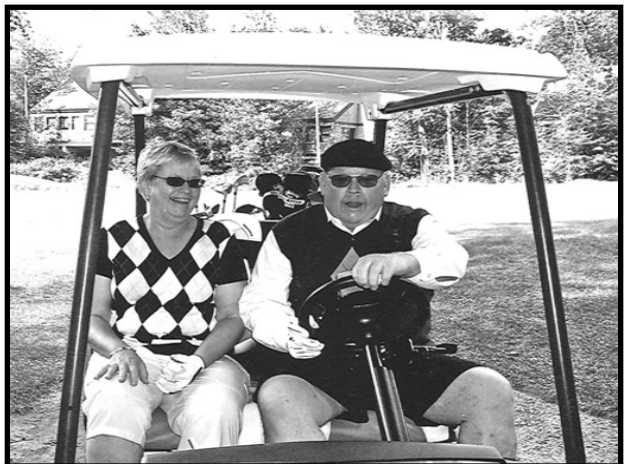

In March of 2006, Wayne Swanson was diagnosed with stage 3 melanoma. With Sylvia at his side, he endured 3 surgeries followed by 12 months of after-treatment.

200 golfers and spectators raise \$29,857 for this worthy cause.

With an understanding of the hurdles facing patients with this disease and to raise awareness of melanoma, in 2007 they started the Swanson Melanoma Open golf tournament at Breezy Point Resort's Traditional Golf Course.

RCI QUESTIONS

1. What are "lock-off" units?

Lock-off units are large lodging units resulting from the combination of 2 or more individual units joined by common interlocking doors, similar to adjoining rooms in a hotel. The lock-off unit allows the owner the flexibility to bank part of the unit with RCI, use in RCI's Points program, place one part of the unit in the Resort's rental program or use the entire lock-off unit.

Lock-offs can include the combination of a 2 bedroom unit with a 1 bedroom unit, 2 bedroom unit with a 2 bedroom unit or a 2 bedroom unit with a 1 bedroom studio unit. One annual maintenance fee covers the entire lock-off.

2. If I make reservation less than 48 hours in advance, is it possible that the Resort will not be aware of my arrival?

Yes. Your reservation resides in RCI's reservations system and may not have been received by the Resort prior to your arrival.

Please print and bring with you a copy of your RCI reservation record to expedite your check-in.

3. Can I use my ID card at Antlers?

Yes. Any timeshare owner with the *updated ID card* receives a 10% discount when dining at Antler's, Dockside and Marina II as well as a 10% discount at the Gift Shop.

4. Does a rivalry between Breezy Point Resort and Breezy Point Timeshare prevent us from using all of the amenities at the Resort?

No. All timeshare owners and their guests are welcome to use the Resort's pool and other amenities at the Breezy Center. In addition, the use of the tennis courts, boat launch and the Resort's beaches are for the use of all guests.

The pool facility at the Breezy Inn & Suites is reserved for Breezy Inn & Suites guests only.

Various timeshare associations have built their own pool facilities, such as those at Whitebirch Estates, High Village, Pelican Bay and Pelican Center. The use of these facilities is restricted to the timeshare owners and guests in those member associations.

5. When making an RCI exchange I'm asked if my maintenance fees are paid. If I am banking 2 or 3 years ahead, how do I do that?

Simply contact Owner Services at 218 562-7155. You will be able to pay the maintenance fees for future years. Should there be a remaining balance when the future year's dues are assessed, you will be billed for the difference. Failure to do this will result in RCI's denial of your banking request.

Use Caution When Selling or Renting Your Timeshare

Several timeshare owners have reported being contacted by companies offering to sell, buy or rent their timeshare. As an inducement, they claim to have a buyer ready to purchase the timeshare or assurances they can sell it.

In all cases, the owner is being told that they must pay up-front fees as high as \$5000 for services, closing costs or other fees. Once the money is received these companies often disappear.

Adding insult to injury, after the company gets the money from the owner they take no action to sell, buy or rent the owner's week or relieve the owner of the ongoing responsibility for association fees.

The following are tips to protect yourself:

- Be wary of up-front fees.

- Don't agree to anything before researching the company.
- Demand everything in writing.
- Don't be tricked by fancy sounding addresses or titles.
- If it sounds too good to be true, it probably is!

Under no circumstances should you pay in advance any fees for the sale or rental of your timeshare.

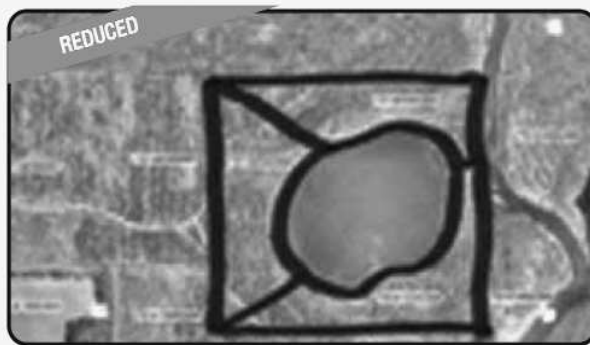
